


## West Gippsland Rainfall Outlook – 20 November 2025


### Past Rainfall

- Month to date rainfall in West Gippsland is has reached average or above average for November.
- Most of the region has received more than 100 mm so far in November.
- Spring (September to November) rainfall has been average.
- Root zone soil moisture is above average over most of West Gippsland. Deep layer soil moisture remains much below average reflecting dry conditions in previous months.

### Outlook

- Around 25 mm of rain is forecast for West Gippsland over the eight days to 27 November 2025.
- There is a 75% chance of around 15 mm of rain in the following two weeks between 24 November to 7 December.

- The December 2025 to February 2026 outlook for West Gippsland indicates a roughly equal chance of above or below average rainfall. Forecast certainty is low.
- There is a 75% chance of at least 100 mm of rain over most of West Gippsland between December and February.
