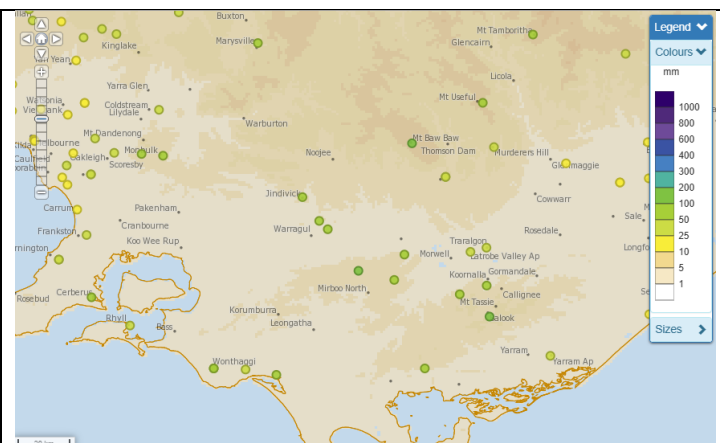


West Gippsland Rainfall Outlook – 25 September 2025

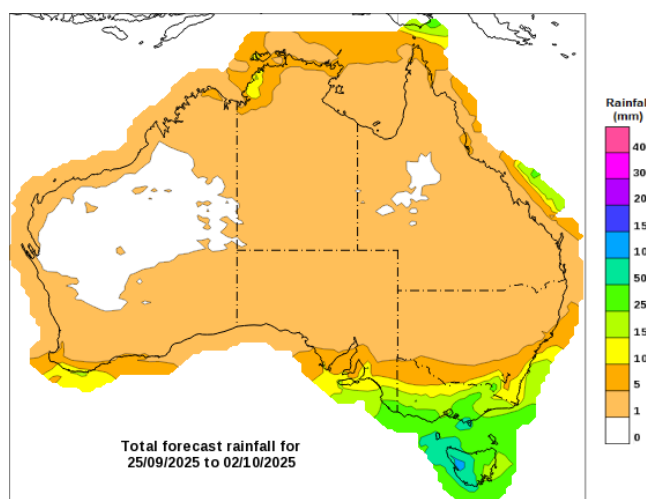
Past Rainfall

- Rainfall during September is tracking below average for the month in most locations.
- Soil moisture remains below average for the season over most of west Gippsland.

Outlook

- 25-50 mm of rain is forecast for West Gippsland over the eight days to 2nd October 2025.
- There is about a 50% chance of above median rainfall (approx. 37 mm) for the following two weeks of October (6th – 19th)

- The October to December outlook for West Gippsland indicates a 55-65% chance that rainfall will exceed the historical median.
- There are a wide range of possible rainfall outcomes, but model runs are biased towards wetter than normal conditions.
- There is a 75% chance of at least 200 mm of rain over most of West Gippsland between October and December.
