






West Gippsland Rainfall Outlook – 28 August 2025


Past Rainfall

- August has been dry in West Gippsland with most locations receiving less than half the monthly average (to 28 August).
- Soil moisture remains very much below average for the season.

Outlook

- 25-50 mm of rain is forecast for West Gippsland over the eight days to 4 September 2025.
- There is about a 50% chance of above median rainfall for the following two weeks of September.
- See <u>Water and the Land: Forecast</u> <u>Rainfall</u> or <u>MetEye</u>



- The October to December outlook for West Gippsland indicates a 60-70% chance that rainfall will exceed the historical median.
- There are a wide range of possible rainfall outcomes, but model runs are biased towards wetter than normal conditions.
- There is a 75% chance of at least 200 mm of rain over most of West Gippsland between October and December.
