






West Gippsland Rainfall Outlook – 6 November 2025


Past Rainfall

- October rainfall in West Gippsland was mostly average, with above average falls in the south.
- Around 20-30 mm has fallen over the region in the first week of November.
- Root zone soil moisture is now average or above over most of West Gippsland.
 Deep layer soil moisture remains much below average reflecting dry conditions in previous months.

Outlook

- 25-50 mm of rain is forecast for West Gippsland over the eight days to 13 November 2025.
- There is a 75% chance of around 25 mm of rain in the following two weeks between 10 and 23 November.

- The December 2025 to February 2026 outlook for West Gippsland indicates a 55-60% chance that rainfall will exceed the historical median for the period.
- There are a wide range of possible rainfall outcomes. Model runs are slightly biased towards wetter than normal conditions.
- There is a 75% chance of at least 100 mm of rain over most of West Gippsland between December and February.
- Regularly check <u>Rainfall The chance of</u> <u>above median for November to January</u> for up to date information.
